



## BE FRAUD SMART

Recognize it. Report it. Stop it.

### Do's

- Do set up security alerts with online banking.
- Do be very careful with your social insurance number and other personal information
- Do choose difficult passwords and change them often.
- Do check your accounts and credit card statements regularly.
- Do alert your Credit Union immediately if anything is wrong with your accounts.
- Do use antivirus and antispyware
- Do sign the back of your cards in permanent ink.
- Do inform the card issuers if you are traveling.
- Do sign up for free scam alerts at [ftc.gov/scams](http://ftc.gov/scams).
- Do be skeptical of free trial offers.
- Do keep all software updates current

### Don'ts

- Don't give out your personal identification number (PIN) to anyone.
- Don't give all your member cards and credit cards the same PIN number.
- Don't trust pop-up windows.
- Don't trust random emails claiming to be someone you trust asking for personal information.
- Don't let anyone else use your debit or credit cards.
- Don't write your PIN on your cards.
- Don't give any credit card information to anyone soliciting sales over the phone.
- Don't give account information to anyone calling and claiming to be your card issuer. If the call was from your card issuer they would have your information already.
- Don't deposit a cheque from an unknown source that is asking you to wire money back.
- Don't pay upfront for something promised. Example: job, prize, free samples.

### Spot an Imposter

Scammers will often pretend to be someone you trust, like a government official, a charity, a company they have learned you do business with and even a family member. Always remember don't send money or give out personal information to an unexpected request, whether it comes as a text message, a phone call or an email. If someone contacts you looking for personal information or money, hang up. If you think the caller might be telling the truth, call back to a number which you know to be genuine.
